Queensland Pedal Prix riders who are past students or currently in years 7 to 12:

This is our third year, and the teams are made up of experienced riders from Queensland schools/clubs.

- Categories we are entering:
 - S1 Middle School (under 16) Max 16 riders
 - S2 Senior School (under 19) Max 12 riders
 - Possibly C6 Community (past students under 20) max 14 riders
(* Bus can take a maximum of 28 riders)
- Riders over the age of 18 must have a current volunteers Blue Card (QLD Working with Children check)
- All riders must agree to the conditions and abide by directions given by the Team Manager.

We will take a bus down and back from Daisy Hill, Brisbane leaving Wednesday 16th of September and returning Monday 21st. Of September.

-\$350 to cover entry fee, transport and food. This is subsidised by Faith Christian School Sports Program. **IF** you are flying to SA, you will still be charged the full cost.

*Uniforms are to be purchased separately, details to follow

** Riders may fly down and will need to be in Murray Bridge no later than 9am on Friday, no exceptions. This will be at your own expense.

State Team Entry Conditions:

1. The sole purpose of the state team is to compete in the Murray Bridge 24-hour event.
2. No alcohol or smoking (including vaping and e-cigarettes) at any time on the trip
3. All riders must be race fit (Beep level test 10 and above)
4. All riders must follow the directions of the Team Manager, other State Rep Team Staff and Team Captains.
5. Riders 18 years + must have a current Blue Card (Volunteer safe working with Children)
6. Riders need to pay their own airfare (if applicable) and team fee
7. Full QLD State Team Uniform to be purchased for this event
8. No other School/Team uniforms are to be worn while traveling to and from or while at Murray Bridge
9. Modest dress is expected. This is to emphasises modesty, neatness, and unity through compulsory wearing of Pedal Prix Team uniform when in public. The following are not allowed when traveling with the team: Sagging pants, ripped jeans, tank tops, halter tops, sleeveless tops of any description and short shorts. Clothing displaying drugs, alcohol, tobacco, profanity, or hate speech are also not allowed. Shoulders must be covered at all times.
**Leggings/ bike shorts are allowed when paired with a t-shirt of appropriate length. (covering of lower back and abdomen)
10. All riders need to complete the Medical Form for this event
11. Accommodation will be trackside in tents.
12. Team members need to bring their own gear including:
 - a. Helmet, safety glasses, glasses, water bottle clip in Shimano shoes.
 - b. Sleeping bag and pillow suitable for camping trackside at Murray Bridge. September temperatures range between 7° - 20°. Tents and stretchers will be provided.
 - c. Personal toiletries and clothing
13. The expectation is that all riders will stay for the duration of the event at the track and will not be allowed to leave unless for medical reasons.

**All parents attending must sign a volunteer agreement and be available to marshal during the race, this includes completing marshal training beforehand.

Parents who do not agree to these requirements will not be permitted in the pit area and will be asked to watch from the designated spectator area further along the track.
